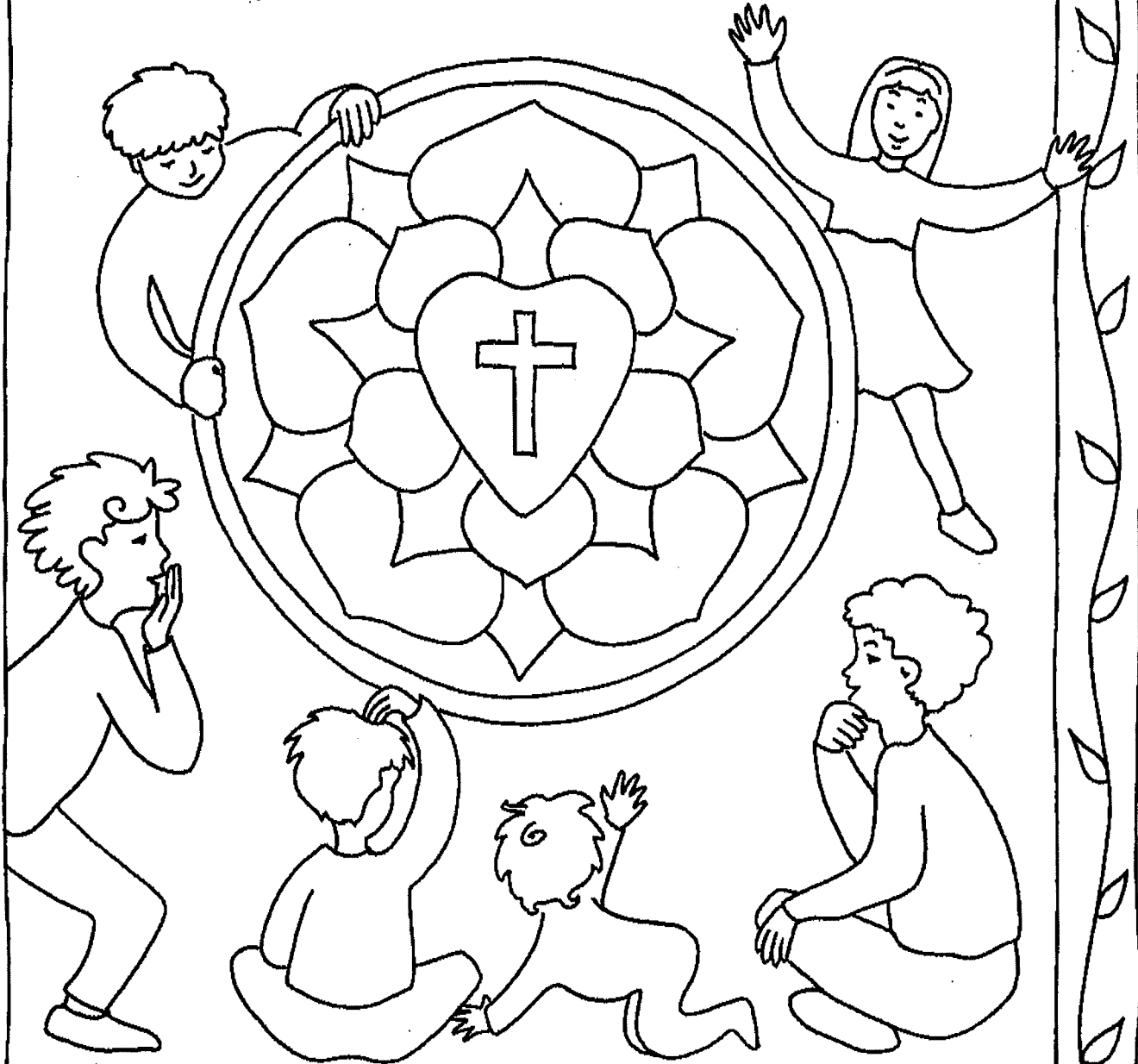


I'm a Lutheran

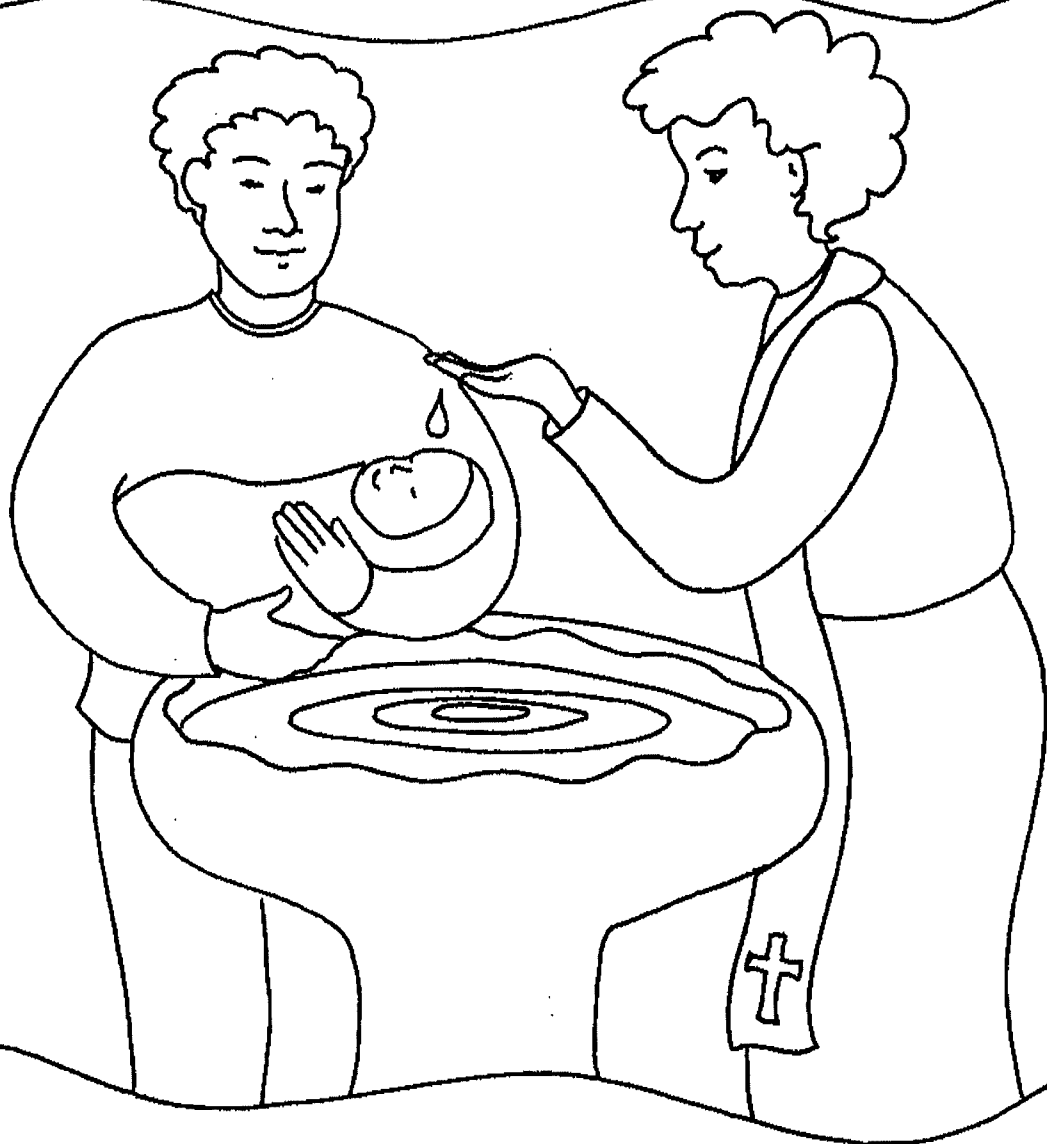


What does that mean to me?

belonging to my family.

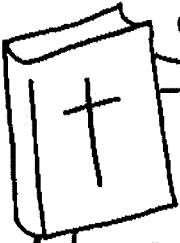


At baptism I was born anew!

forgiven again for heaven's sake!



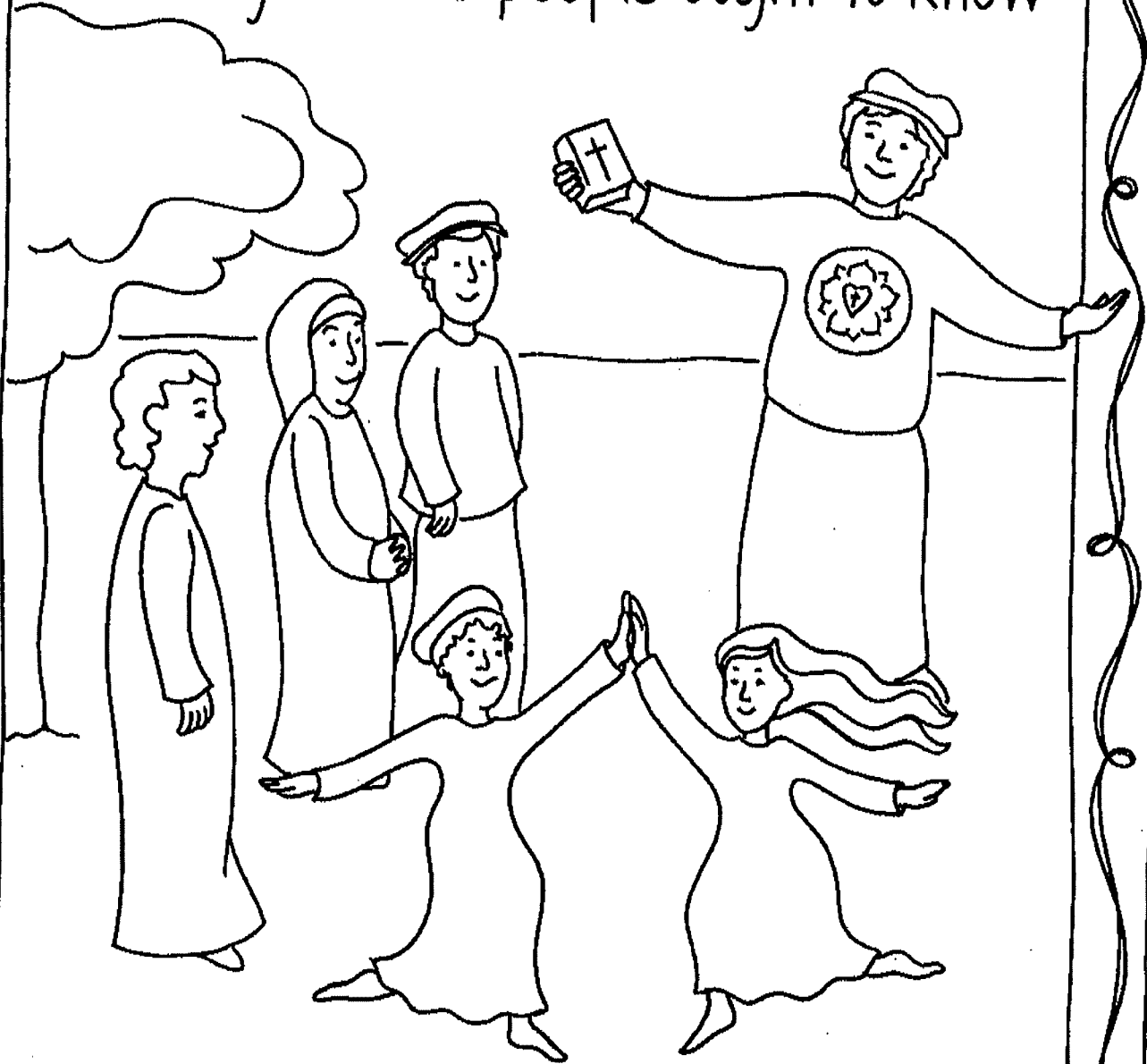
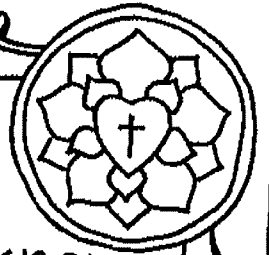


The Bible is God's Holy Book!
God's love in action take a look!

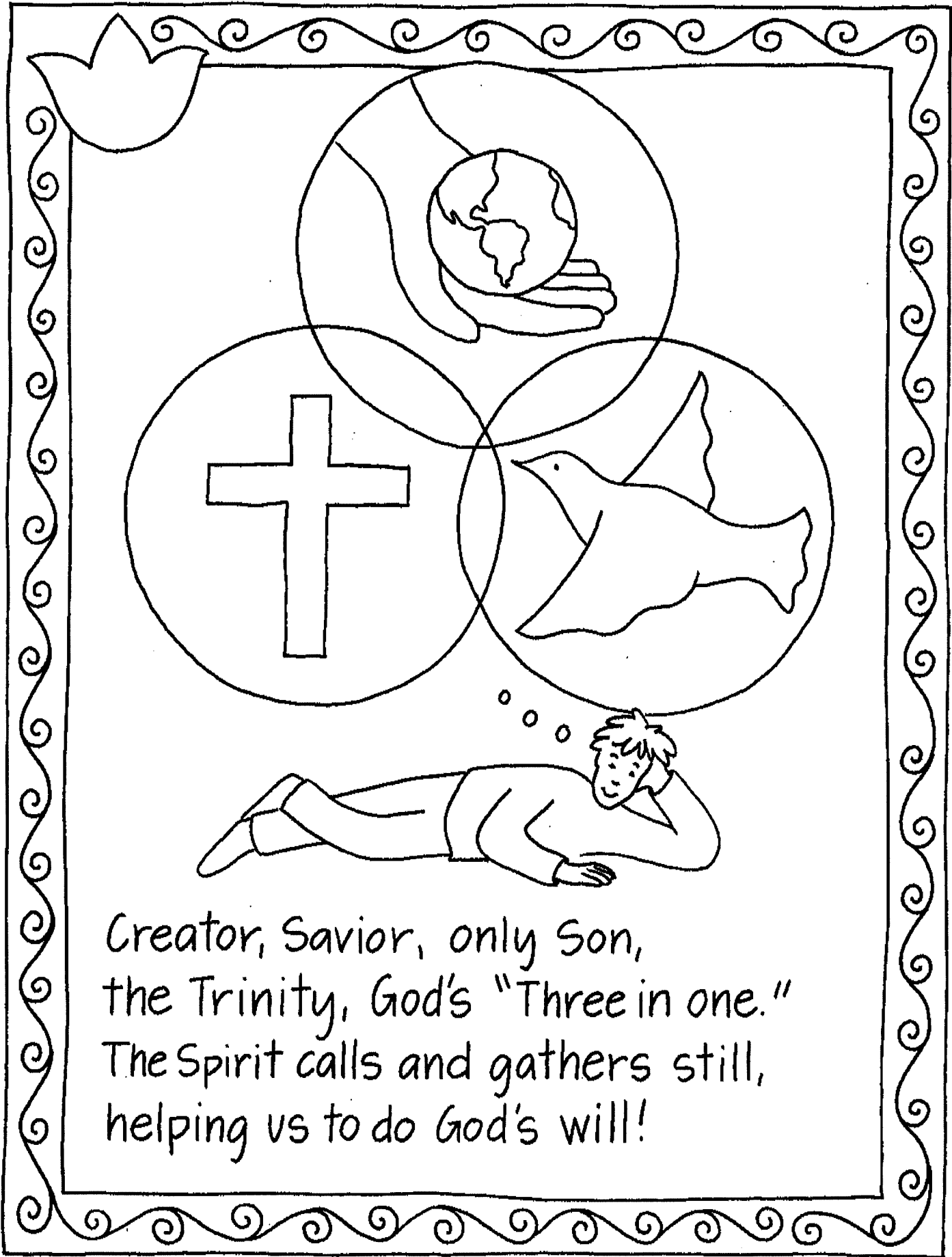


God's love shown through all history,
