

Jesus did this for us.**




Entrance into Jerusalem

The people of Jerusalem greet Jesus as he enters the city. They throw palm branches and robes on the ground as he passes them.




Jesus and the Moneychangers

with a kiss.**




How Many Pieces of Silver?

Judas, another disciple, turned Jesus into the Temple police for 30 pieces of silver.




The Cock

During LENT we drape the cross with a purple cloth, which is a symbol for remembrance.




The Centurion
