Thank you, if enough people gather together to do this, it would only be once a year. We appreciate your thoughtfulness and time in consideration.



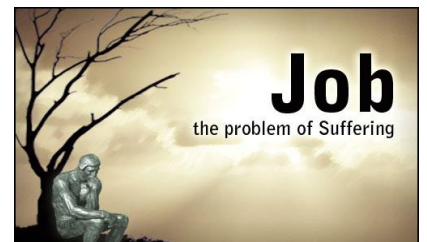
WOMEN'S RETREAT

BACK IN LIBERIA:

A SUMMARY PLAN AND WORK PROGRESS REPORT

Brethren, the Lord be with you.

I am pleased to report to you that I am in Liberia after a very thirty-six hour-long journey. I

praise our God for the safe travel, and the warmth of the reception of the people and the team of workers here. It was a great and inspiring time.

I continue to appreciate the dedication of the people to the work despite the challenges they continue to face in the country

As a part of the next five-year revolving plan, we are trusting the Lord Jesus Christ, through the Holy Spirit, to help us start one hundred and one churches, a Bible college; recruit three hundred church workers for discipleship, mission, evangelism, and church leadership training; help with the construction of ten churches; and one Christian high school.

For 2018/2019 operational year, we are looking to the leading and empowering of the Holy Spirit to start ten churches and begin the Bible college with at least ten students for the 2019/2020 academic year. In addition, we are trusting that we will recruit one hundred of the three hundred people and begin the training and equipping.

We have already begun this process through region one with the training of lay and clergy members for mission, evangelism, church planting, church leadership, and discipleship. This training would be followed up with an advanced level.

Furthermore, we will continue to assist with external materials as the construction of the Sanniquillie church continues; and provided

minimum assistance and supervision with the expansion of the Dwazon church. The Tienii, Kakata II, Bacon Town, Buchanan, Gbesseh, Nagbena, and Nyeila churches would receive external materials assistance to assist with the starting of the construction.

Please continue to pray for us that the Lord will continue to hold our hands, give us wisdom, and keep us faithful, and healthy.

Please accept our thanks and appreciation for your prayers, support, critique, and suggestions as we strive to do the work our God has called us to. Without your prayers and support the work would not have been to where it is now. We continue to remain grateful.
